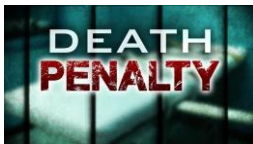

Focus: Death Penalty

Amnesty has just published its survey of the Death Penalty worldwide in 2016. It's a mixed picture; whilst the number of executions carried out is down by more than a third compared with 2015, the number of people sentenced to death has reached a record high. Amnesty recorded **1,032** executions in 23 countries compared to 1,634 in 2015. However **3,117** people were sentenced to death – the highest number ever recorded in a single year. Nearly 19,000 people languish on death rows worldwide. These figures do not include China where the actual number of executions is unknown. Iran, Saudi Arabia, Iraq and Pakistan join China as the world's top five executioners. The US executed the fewest number of people for 25 years (20). Executions in Iran were also down significantly. Two countries, Benin and Nauru abolished the death penalty for all crimes; it brings to 141 the number of abolitionist countries; 59 retain the death penalty.

Human Rights Defenders at Risk: Petition the UAE

Ahmed Mansoor is a human rights activist and blogger in the United Arab Emirates (UAE). He was arrested under mysterious circumstances by state security in March under cyber-crime charges. Prior to his arrest, he was the last remaining free human rights activist working in UAE. The UN has expressed its deep concern for the crackdown on human rights activists across the UAE *"We regard Mr Mansoor's arrest and detention as a direct attack on the legitimate work of human rights defenders in the UAE...[his] outstanding work in the protection of human rights and the advancement of democracy...is of great value not only to the UAE but for the whole region"*. Over the past five years Ahmed has been assaulted and has faced numerous death threats. Amnesty has an [online petition](#) for Ahmed Mansoor.
