In Turkey, people who have dedicated their lives to defending the human rights of journalists, activists and other dissenting voices are themselves in danger.

Ten of them, including Idil Eser of Amnesty International and Özlem Dalkıran of Avaaz and Citizens' Assembly, were arrested in Istanbul on 5 July. Known as the Istanbul 10 they, along with Amnesty's Taner Kılıç, are being tried for terrorism-related crimes – an absurd accusation intended to stifle their human rights activism. They are currently in prison.

The Istanbul 10 are: Idil Eser, Özlem Dalkıran, Günal Kurşun, Veli Acu, Ali Gharavi, Peter Steudtner, İlknur Üstün, Şeyhmus Özbekli, Nejat Taştan and Nalan Erkem. Taner Kılıç is being tried with them.
