- to lobby the government to provide more English classes for refugees;
- to change the law so that divided refugee families can be reunited.

HOW TO CONTACT YOUR MP

Write to your MP @: House of Commons, London SW1A 0AA To telephone their office at the House of Commons, call 020 7219 3000 and ask to be put through to their office giving your MP's name. To phone your MP at their local constituency office, you will find the contact details at your local town hall or library. You must include your own address when you write to your MP.

DONATIONS REQUIRED

There are local and national charities in the UK offering support to refugees – please continue to give generously to those charities.

One such charity is **Refugees Aid Northwest**. They urgently need basic essential items to provide comfort to Syrian refugees of all ages as they approach what could be a long, cold winter. These items are urgently needed: **tents**, **sleeping bags**, warm clothes for all ages, coats, shoes and boots, small bottles of hand sanitiser, baby wipes, pouches of baby food, tinned fruit, veg and chick peas, breakfast bars and tinned fish, basic medical supplies such as paracetamol

Items will be sent with the support of Manchester-based Syrian Aid to the Greek/Macedonian border, the island of Samos and Syria.
