#### **Letters and Petitions**

We wrote letters and e-mails on behalf of human rights defender Shackelia Jackson from Jamaica and on behalf of Taner Kiliç and Idil Eser, the Chair and Director of Amnesty Turkey. We also wrote to our MPs about rights for refugees. **SEE FRONT PAGE FOR DETAILS**.

#### **Secretary**

Al UK monthly mailing (i) news about Idil Eser and the Amnesty Turkey prosecutions with calls for continued letters and emails (see below and front page) (ii) more details of Write for Rights including the launch of this year's campaign at the Houses of Parliament on 6<sup>th</sup> December; (iii) details of an action to persuade MPs to relax some of the restrictive rules on refugees; and (vi) booking details for the National Conference & AGM 2018 on 7th-8th April at Swansea University – 1<sup>st</sup> November booking opens, 7<sup>th</sup> January deadline for resolutions and 1<sup>st</sup> March bookings close.

#### Treasurer.
