Letters and Petitions. We wrote cards (5) to Tep Vanny, a Cambodian Human Rights Defender and sent emails (4) on his behalf; we sent cards (2) to and letters (2) on behalf of Esmail Abdi a teacher and trade unionist on hunger strike in Iran and signed a petition on his behalf; and wrote letters to Ayatollah Khamenei on behalf of Nazanin Zarghari-Ratcliffe and sent her cards (5). We also decided that I would write on to Sir David Amess MP as he sent an e-mail on behalf of Nazanin Zarghari-Ratcliffe at our WfR event and ask what the government is doing about her case.
