Taner Kiliç –

Imprisoned in Turkey on false charges.



Taner Kiliç has spent one year in prison and there is still no sign that he will be acquitted. Police detained the Chair of Amnesty International Turkey on 6th June 2017. He was arrested on suspicion of having links with a terrorist organization. His arrest came after Amnesty published a very critical report on the escalating crackdown on human rights by the Turkish authorities following a failed coup attempt in July 2016. Tens of thousands of public sector employees have been dismissed and hundreds of journalists and media workers detained. Hundreds of media outlets and NGOs have been shut down. Taner Kiliç has served on the board of Amnesty International Turkey and has been Chair since 2014. During his decades of human rights work in Turkey he has consistently demonstrated an unswerving commitment to human rights.

'The evidence of Taner's innocence is emphatic. His detention is a gross injustice that exposes Turkey's flawed justice system and the government's cold-blooded pursuit of anyone deemed to oppose them'

Tep Vanny - Cambodia



Tep Vanny is a symbol of peaceful activism in Cambodia and is currently in jail as a result of her brave determination to defend the rights of others.

She is a housing rights activist and for almost 10 years has been defending her community in central Phnom Penh where thousands of families have been forcibly evicted from their homes.

Along with her fellow activists, many of them women, she has been targeted by the authorities and harassed, beaten, arrested and imprisoned. The government are attempting to silence her voice and show activists like her what can happen if you stand up for your rights and the rights of others.
