<u>From the last meeting</u>: the stall at the Leigh Folk Festival had been useful and attracted a few petition signatures and £47 in the collection box. Mike had e-mailed Sir David Amess about Boris Johnson's promise not to let up on Nazanin Zaghari-Ratcliffe but as Boris had resigned had asked Sir David to take up her case with the new Foreign Secretary, Jeremy Hunt.

<u>Letters and Petitions.</u> We wrote letters (5) to our MPs about the BRAVE Campaign; sent cards (6) to **Rodrigo Mundaca**, a water rights activist in Chile, plus 1 letter to the Minister of the Interior on his behalf; and we sent letters (6) and an e-mail to the Head of the Ukrainian Police on behalf of LGBTI activist **Vitalina Kaval**.
