Start: Hyde Park Corner (Exit 1)**

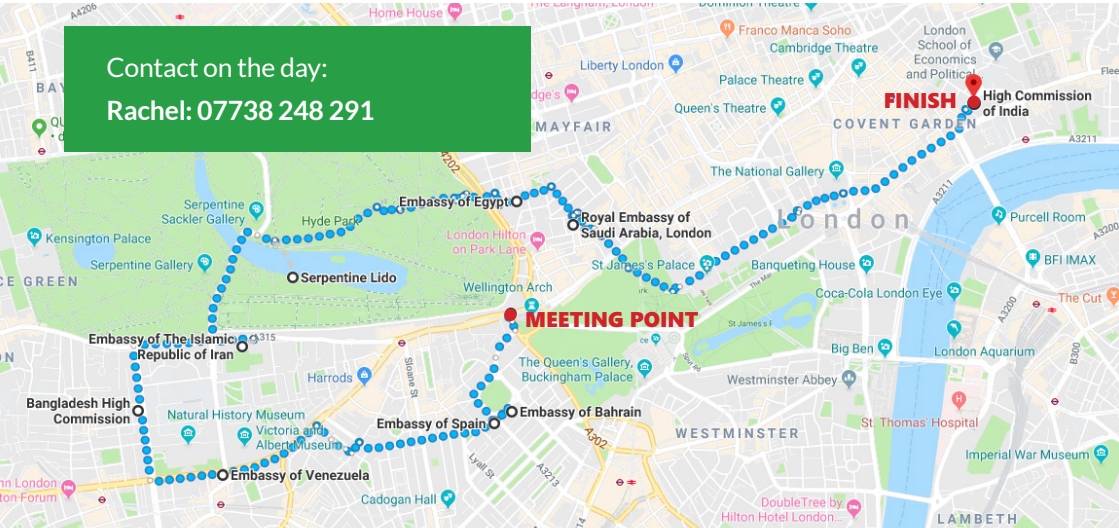
100 years ago (some) British women finally won the right to vote. The incredible work and spirit of the suffragettes who made that possible is alive today throughout the world.

Women are routinely attacked for both their sex and for being human rights defenders. In many cases they challenge the accepted norms and stereotypes in their society to fight injustices. Because of this, they face harassment, imprisonment, and sometimes even death.

So please join us on our Embassy Crawl on 29 September to show countries around the world that the women they persecute do not stand alone.

We meet at **Hyde Park Corner** just inside the Apsley Gate (near the Lodge Cafe). Take Exit 1 from the tube station (Piccadilly line) and, once up the steps, walk along the pavement and follow the crowd.

We will stop for lunch in Hyde Park at the Lido Café bar (after a handful of embassies) but feel free to bring your own food. If possible, please wear a suffragette colour (green, purple, white) or sash. Remember to check the weather forecast and come prepared if rain is threatened.
