PROCESS FOR THE AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL UNITED KINGDOM SECTION BOARD ELECTIONS

Assuming there are more candidates than places on the Board, a ballot will be held. Members will be able to vote either by post or online. If there are an equal number or fewer candidates than places, then those candidates will be elected unopposed.

If you want to know whether or not an election is required for any particular category of place and/or the number of candidates standing for that category of place, please contact Selma Shirazi on 020 7033 1505 after the closing date for nominations (5pm on 1 February 2019).

Candidates may withdraw their nominations in writing to the Returning Officer by 3 February 2019.

If an election is to be held ballot papers will be circulated to members from 22 February 2019. Members will be able to vote up until 30 April 2019. The results of any election will be declared as soon as possible after the declaration date on Friday 28 June 2019 and will be published in the Amnesty International UK Section's Magazine and website thereafter.
