

Northern Ireland: Abortion is Not A Crime

The highest court in the land has ruled Northern Ireland's abortion laws are in breach of the UK's own human rights obligations. Northern Ireland is the only place in the UK where women can face up to life in prison for having an abortion. Theresa May can no longer do nothing whilst countless women continue to suffer on her watch.

I call on the Secretary of State to ensure that Northern Ireland's abortion law is brought in line with international human rights standards, which must include the decriminalisation of abortion. Furthermore, they must stop the criminalisation of women and girls who access abortion pills – an internationally recommended option for safely ending pregnancies in the first trimester.
