Creative Fundraisers

Sponsored Litter Pick: Emma, a university student at the University of Exeter, asked people to sponsor her to do a series of walks around her local area picking up rubbish. The walks were only a few kilometers each but the amount of rubbish she was able to clear was incredible! She ended upraising nearly £800 in donations via a <u>Just Giving page</u>. We loved this fundraiser because not only did it raise money to help support important human rights work but it also helped clean-up the community.





26-miles for refugees: we have had some Amnesty International UK supporters take on the challenge to run, jog or walk 26-miles in a day in support of refugees. They choose the number 26 because it's the number of miles in a marathon and there are 26 million refugees worldwide – the perfect combination of fundraising and awareness raising! If 26-miles is a bit much, you could do this in a group. Each of you could run a few miles until you've done 26 between you. <u>Setup a Just Giving page</u> and ask for donations.

Virtual Quizzes: holding a quiz is a great way to socialise with friends and family in lockdown and it can also be a fundraiser. Either charge for entry to the quiz or ask people taking part to donate to Amnesty International UK. You could have a human rights round to help educate those taking part.
