

# Amnesty International UK Risk assessment summary for Covid-19

**Amnesty International UK takes the wellbeing and safety of its staff; volunteers, visitors, and anyone connected with us, very seriously.**

We have completed a comprehensive risk assessment, following the guidance issued by the Government and the devolved governments of the UK, and have implemented a range of measures to manage the risk of Covid-19 cross contamination and transmission. These include:

- Taking all reasonable steps to help and support staff to continue working from home.
- Putting in place and communicating social distancing arrangements in our workplaces.
- Encouraging handwashing and hygiene procedures in line with Government guidance and promoting this with signage and posters
- Managing the capacity of our workplaces to maintain safe occupancy levels and to reduce the likelihood of transmission.
- Enhancing our cleaning regimes.

Our risk assessment is reviewed and regularly updated by Amnesty International UK's Facilities team to ensure measures are still relevant and being implemented
