Last year we sent over 800 cards and letters, using case histories provided by Amnesty International. We supply cards and envelopes, plus craft materials for younger campaigners. We will have our own Whalley Range cards available, courtesy of local photographer Ollie Morris. If you can afford to, please make a contribution to cover materials and postage. Live entertainment will include the Beech Band and Open Voice Choir. There will be food, savoury and sweet (Tibetan Kitchen will have a mobile unit outside), and hot and cold drinks available, and you will once again be able to enjoy mulled cider! Shopping opportunities will include Palestine Solidarity Campaign, Kimbilio, and News from Nowhere bookshop. And, yes, I'm afraid they do take credit cards at the bookstall!
