This month's fundraising update focuses on a collection held at the Racecourse Ground in Wexham as part of our Football Welcomes campaign. Wales win 4-0 and Chester and Wrexham Amnesty Group raised £450!

The Welsh FA got in touch to ask Amnesty International UK to ask if we would like to hold a collection at the Welsh Women's European Championship qualifier that took place on April 9th at the home of Wrexham A.F.C. This was to mark Football Welcomes month, a month of activities celebrating the contribution of refugees to football and the UK more broadly organised by Amnesty International UK and supported by the Premier League, Women's Super League, Scottish Premiership and other leagues/FAs across the country. As the local group closest to the stadium, the Chester and Wrexham group were delighted to get involved. They sent four collectors (with very little notice so thank you!) and raised £450 for Amnesty International UK (as well as getting to witness the Welsh Women's Team kick off their qualification campaign with a commanding 4-0 win!) They also took the opportunity to talk to the crowd about the group and the work of Amnesty International more generally.
