

Booksale in Edinburgh

The East Edinburgh Amnesty Group held the latest edition of their regular book sale fundraiser last week and their treasurer Mary Jane got in touch to tell us about it:

"Our local Amnesty local group has held a book sale in Portobello for more than 10 years. This has grown over the years. It has been great fun even though it has been a lot of work gathering books, baking, organising the café, running the event, collecting, storing and passing on surplus books at the end of the event. For the past 2 years a local book shop has bought some books from us at the end of the sale. We have tried different things to increase interest and income at the event including crafts from the local Woodcraft group, live music, highlighting Amnesty campaigns and gathering signatures. This year we had a new venture. Some local artists contributed their works and this had a significant impact on the money we raised. We have raised more money than on previous sales and we are delighted to have passed on £1000 to Amnesty UK this year."

It's great to see an event like this grow and develop new sources of income over the years. Thanks so much to Mary Jane and everyone else who makes this wonderful event possible.
