## Ely Amnesty Group's Annual Speaker Event

The Ely group recently got in touch to tell us about the latest edition of their Amnesty Talks event:

"The Ely group started holding Amnesty Talks in 2017. We aim for three talks from January to March. Subjects have ranged from 'Migrant Smuggling into Europe' to our most recent talk 'Inside Putin's Russia'. The challenge, of course, is finding a speaker and a subject that will draw people in – our audience sizes do vary from a handful more than the Ely group members to the 50 plus who turned out to hear Russian born and educated Marina Burrell talk about what ordinary people think of Putin,

his fake historical claims for invading Ukraine and the consequences of that war on both Russia and Ukraine. We have found that the Talks bring in people new to Amnesty, raise the profile of the group and bring in some donations."

The talks organised by the Ely group are free of charge, but they do ask for donations meaning they always raise a modest amount with the more well attended talks doing very well. It's always worth giving people the chance to donate at any event that showcases the important human rights work Amnesty International UK and Amnesty local groups organise. People will often want to make a financial contribution after hearing about campaigns so give them the opportunity to do this!
