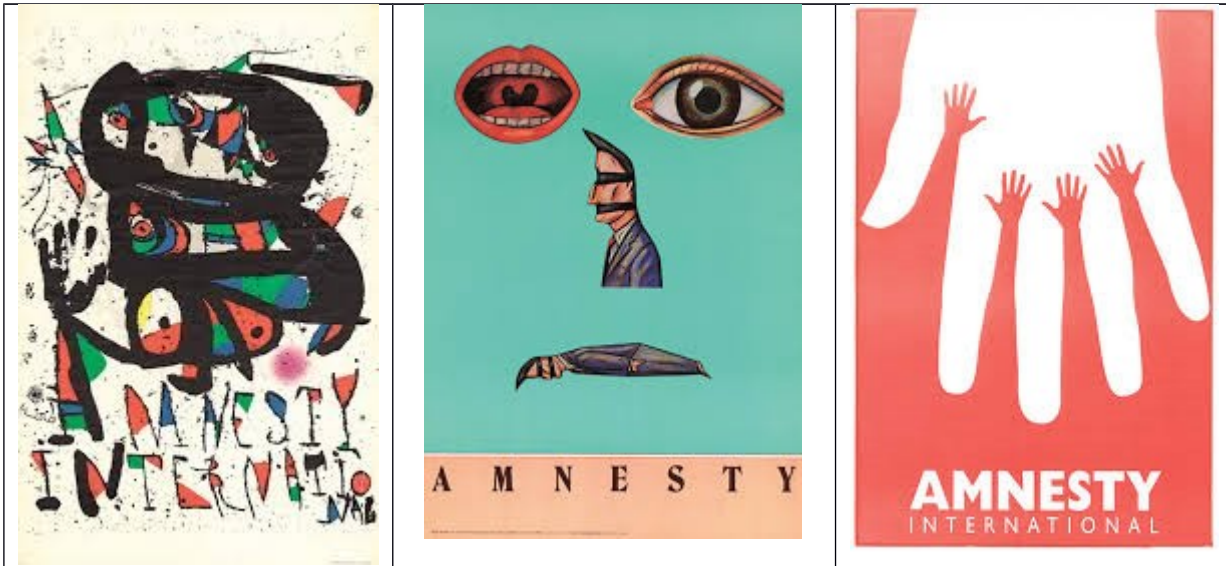


Art Works For Amnesty
