Please select the correct letter for your MP.

Briefing your MP

To accompany the letter, you will also find a briefing for your MP attached. This is for you to hand over, email or post to your MP for them to use in the debate. It is incredibly important to write to MP's irrespective of their view of the HRA. Your MP may not agree with their party line and your letter could help to persuade MPs from the unsupportive parties to speak out in defence of the HRA.
