INTERNATIONAL ISSUES SUB-COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

IISC

1. To provide advice and guidance to the Board of AIUK on major developments of international movement policy.
2. To provide advice and guidance in respect of those policy issues designated as high priority by the AIUK Board for membership-wide consultations, and to set and shape the directions of these consultations.
3. To maintain a watching brief on ICM matters and to advise the Board as to:
 - 1) The desirability of AIUK submitting ICM motions on policy issues
 - 2) Possible responses to other ICM resolutions
 - 3) To provide advice and guidance in respect of policy reviews and studies which form part of ICM Business.
 - 4) To maintain knowledge and familiarity of ICM matters
 - 5) To provide advice and guidance to the Board, at its request, on issues “on the human rights horizon” which may have implications for ICM business.
4. To provide, in partnership with Active Membership Sub-Committee, advice and leadership on the management of AGM Business.
5. To report regularly to the Board and, in particular, to produce an annual report to the Board.
6. To maintain a watching brief on development matters, pending further discussion and decision by the AIUK Board.
7. To undertake such other work as is, from time to time, delegated to the IISC by the Board.
