## Amnesty International UK INTERNATIONAL ISSUES SUB-COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

## IISC

- 1. To provide advice and guidance to the Board of AIUK on major developments of international movement policy.
- 2. To provide advice and guidance in respect of those policy issues designated as high priority by the AIUK Board for membership-wide consultations, and to set and shape the directions of these consultations.
- 3. To maintain a watching brief on ICM matters and to advise the Board as to:
  - 1) The desirability of AIUK submitting ICM motions on policy issues
  - 2) Possible responses to other ICM resolutions
  - 3) To provide advice and guidance in respect of policy reviews and studies which form part of ICM Busines.
  - 4) To maintain knowledge and familiarity of ICM matters
  - 5) To provide advice and guidance to the Board, at its request, on issues "on the human rights horizon" which may have implications for ICM business.
- 4. To provide, in partnership with Active Membership Sub-Committee, advice and leadership on the management of AGM Business.
- 5. To report regularly to the Board and, in particular, to produce an annual report to the Board.
- 6. To maintain a watching brief on development matters, pending further discussion and decision by the AIUK Board.
- 7. To undertake such other work as is, from time to time, delegated to the IISC by the Board.
