Definition Cards

<p>A person who has fled their country and cannot or does not want to go back because a well-founded fear of persecution.</p>	<p>A person who claims they are a refugee and has asked the Government of another country if they can stay there for their safety.</p>
<p>A person who is moving or who has moved away from where they usually live. This could be for a variety of reasons including to find work or to join family. Some move voluntarily whilst others are forced to leave.</p>	<p>To subject a person to prolonged hostility and ill-treatment because of who they are or what they think.</p>
<p>A person who has moved to another part of their own country to find safety because they are scared that they will be treated unfairly, hurt or suffer serious harm.</p>	<p>A person who is legally recognised as belonging to a country or nation, either because they were born there or because they were granted legal status.</p>
<p>The legal international instrument that protects human rights in Europe.</p>	<p>The legal instrument that means that the European Convention on Human Rights is part of UK law.</p>
