The premise of Give it Up is simple: get sponsored to symbolically 'give up' one of your rights in solidarity with those who don't have any choice in the matter. Then donate the money you raised to help us stand for humanity and human rights.

What are you going to give up?

Students at **Ellen Wilkinson School for Girls** in London gave up their right to free expression by holding a sponsored silence. To attract attention to what they were doing they spent much of the day with their mouths taped shut!

Lots of other groups including the Knox Academy Amnesty Group in Scotland and the **Eastlea Community School** in London did the dame and raised hundreds of pounds.
