2.0 Urgent Actions:

- 2.1 Letters had been written to: Japan where Matsumoto Kenji is sentenced to death; UAE where Muawiya al-Ruwahi is detained for his blogging activities; Ukraine where Ivan Bezyazykov has disappeared; Russian Federation where Amur Abubovich Khakulov is being denied medical treatment in a high security penal colony, and where Yekaterina Vologzheninova is to be tried for simply posting a criticism of Russian involvement in the Ukraine.
- 2.2 A letter had been received back from Chechnya Katherine to post on to the Country Coordinator.
- 3.0 **The evening's Film 'Balibo'** Carol gave an introduction to the recent history of East Timor, and the similarity between what had happened in East Timor (the Indonesian invasion and then occupation) and what is continuing to happen in West Papua; the film tells the narrative of a group of Australian and one New Zealander journalists who followed the invasion, and were then murdered by the invading forces. The Group watched the film and had a brief discussion around the topics raised noting that East Timor had managed to gain independence after 24 years of the illegal occupation.
