Meeting on 14th May 2015 at Audrey's home in Benfleet

There were 8 of us at the meeting and we spent most of it writing appeal cards and letters and letters of support for or on behalf of [Moses Akatugba](#) who features in the Stop Torture Campaign; a 12 year old pregnant child in [Paraguay](#); an Urgent Action Case relating to forced eviction in [Burma/Myanmar](#); and [Mahhdi Abu Dheeb](#) in Bahrain and [Mohammed Al Roken](#) in the UAE. Present: Dick, Andrew, Audrey, Jean, Rachel, Martin, Muriel & Mike.

Apologies: Richard, Steve & Maureen, Heidrun and Tricia. We decided to send cards to Maureen and Richard, both of whom are unwell.

Last meeting – Jean has contacted the chairman of the local Zimbabwe group and is waiting to hear back from him. It was suggested that the content of the Ely and Ipswich Groups' websites be looked at. Mike will find out the dates of the next Big Event and Leigh Folk Festival with a view to us having stalls at these. He will also try to find out why we seem to have dropped off the SEC Freshers' Event mailing list.

Stop Torture Campaign - Andrew reported that Claudia Medina Tamariz (Mexico) had been released and while some progress had been made with the campaign against Moses Akatuba's death sentence, that had now stalled. We decided to send more cards on his behalf. There's also an on-line [petition](#). Andrew's latest [Campaign Update](#) is on the website.

Burma – nothing to report except the Urgent Action relating to forced eviction.

Treasurer – we now have access to on-line Banking at the Co-op; Martin and Mike have the Group's security tokens. Martin has obtained copies of last year's statements, which Mike will pass on to Steve for auditing purposes.

Membership – we have received some cheques for subscriptions but only £140 up to the day of the meeting. We need more contributions and support for our two fundraising events.

Fundraising – the date for the proposed **sponsored walk** was turning out to be inconvenient and a date at the end of July or beginning of August would be chosen instead. A walk from Shoebury to Leigh was felt to be better than Hockley Woods (could have been influenced by the number of pubs en route?). Sponsorship forms needed – walkers must have funny hats and high-viz Amnesty jackets!!
