<u>Stop Torture Campaign</u> - Andrew reported that although, of the five "postcard cases", Claudia Medina Tamariz (Mexico) and Moses Akatugba (Nigeria) had been released (as has Ángel Colón in Mexico) no progress seems to have been made for Alfreda Disbarro (Philippines), Ali Aarrass (Morocco) or Dilorom Abdukadirova (Uzbekistan). Andrew's latest **Campaign Update** is on the website. A Stop Torture event is arranged for Southend High School for boys in October and he will approach other schools.

Burma - no recent actions.

Prageeth Eknaligoda (Sri Lanka) – Doug has received the case file for Prageeth Eknaligoda a journalist/cartoonist from Sri Lanka who disappeared in 2010. Actions are focussed on specific dates like the anniversary of his disappearance and Doug has some material prepared for the next meeting.

<u>**Treasurer**</u> – Steve has now completed the audit and the books will be returned to Heidrun when she comes home.

<u>Membership</u> – Mu reported that we had received a total of \pounds 270 (now \pounds 320) up to the day of the meeting. Thanks to everybody who has contributed.
