Fingernails torn off with pliers

On 27 November 2005, while awaiting his exam results, 16-year-old Moses Akatugba was arrested by the Nigerian army, shot in the hand, and charged with stealing mobile phones. After being transferred to a police station, Moses says he was beaten with machetes and batons and had his finger and toe nails torn off with pliers to force him to sign two 'confessions'. After eight years in prison he was sentenced to death by hanging. Moses is currently on death row.

All over the world governments are torturing people like you and me. Thirty years ago Amnesty International helped to secure an historic global ban. But the governments that signed up to it have failed to live up to their promises. They still use torture to obtain 'confessions', silence opposition – or simply to punish.
