Saturday 25 October @ 10:45 **Start: Embankment station**

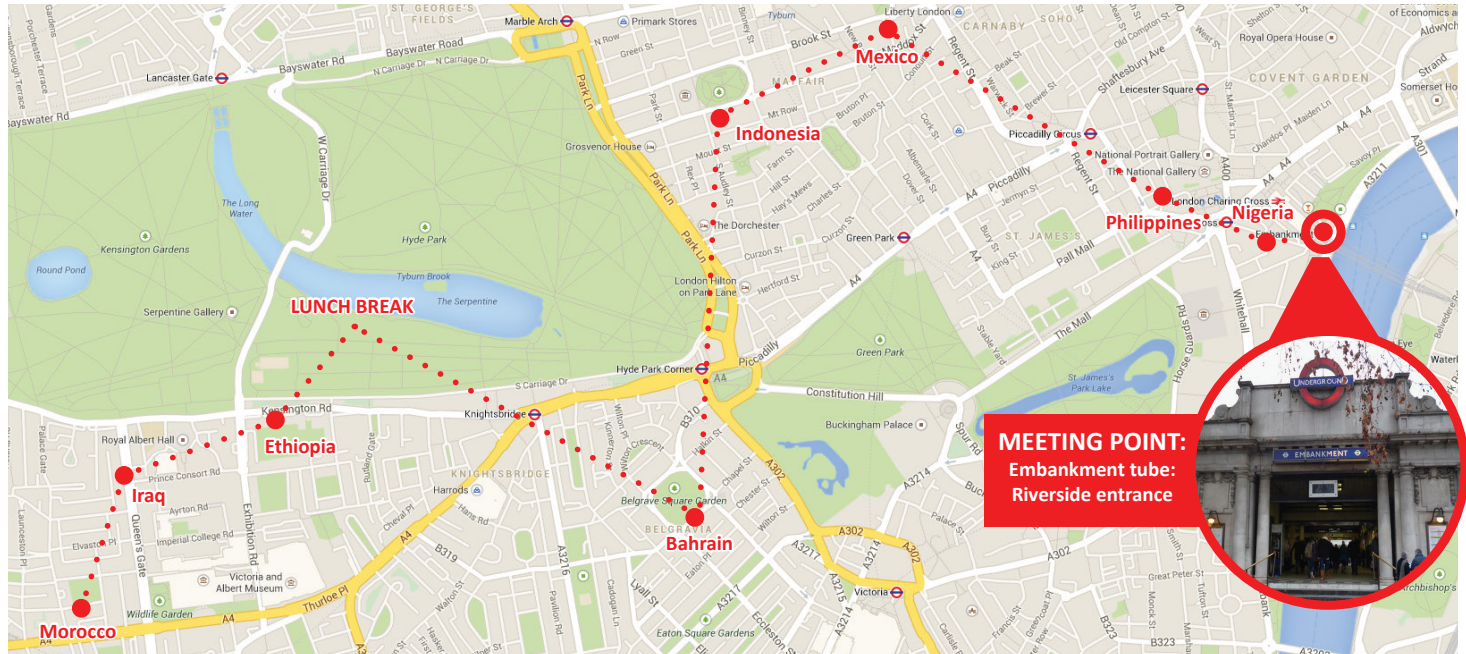
(we'll meet outside the riverside entrance of Embankment Station and set off at 11am)
