Cambridge student 'disappeared' and killed

An Italian student at Cambridge University, Giulio Regeni was conducting his PhD research in Cairo when he was picked up by plainclothes police on 25 January. His body was found beside the Cairo-Alexandria highway on 3 February. An autopsy indicated he had been repeatedly tortured for several days before he died.

The Egyptian authorities deny Giulio was 'disappeared' and tortured to death by state agents, but their varied accounts of the circumstances of his killing have been met with widespread scepticism. Suspicion is also fuelled by their reluctance to conduct a thorough independent investigation.

The Italian government launched its own investigation into Giulio's death. But Egypt failed to provide access to vital evidence, and Italy recalled its ambassador.
