'CONFESSION' FORCED BY BEATING AND ELECTROCUTION

In 1999 journalist Muhammad Bekzhanov was sentenced to 15 years in prison after being tortured into confessing to 'anti-state' offences by security forces. He was due to have been released in February 2012, but shortly before that date he was sentenced to an additional four years and eight months for allegedly violating prison rules. His health has declined sharply in prison. Muhammad was editor-in-chief of the banned Erk political opposition party newspaper when he left Uzbekistan in 1993 due to persecution, harassment and intimidation, only to be forcibly returned from Ukraine in 1999. He is one of the world's longest-imprisoned journalists. An effective investigation into any of the allegations of torture has yet to be conducted.

Things such as postcards from cities around the world with a little description could brighten his days in prison.
