### Human Rights in the UK

#### **HUMAN RIGHTS ARE ENJOYED DAILY IN THE UK**

##### **People enjoy their right to freedom of expression**

eg through debating, performing or writing.

##### **People use their freedom of expression to take a stand against human rights abuses**

eg by campaigning/letter writing/fundraising for the rights of people across the world.

##### **People enjoy their right to vote**

eg in national, local or school council elections.

##### **People enjoy the right to an education**

##### **People enjoy the right to freedom of religious expression**

eg celebrating different religious festivals/ceremonies or being able to attend places of worship.

#### **HUMAN RIGHTS ARE DENIED DAILY IN THE UK**

##### **People are discriminated against due to race, gender, sexuality or disability**

eg people experiencing or taking a stand against these injustices; students taking a stand against bullying in school.

##### **People are denied the right to an adequate standard of living**

eg homelessness, poverty.

##### **People are denied the right to seek asylum**

eg local individuals and their experiences of seeking asylum/being refugees in the UK.
