#### Vacancies on Board of AIUK

- The Student Network can put forward a candidate to only ONE of those seats. Nevertheless, any person who is over 18 years of age and has been a paying member of Amnesty for more than six months can stand for election to the remaining four board seats in their personal capacity.
- If you would like to stand for election to the board as a representative of the Student Network please send a manifesto of no more than 300 words to Jac (jaclarner@gmail.com) by 5pm on 15 December 2013.
- There will then be an online election. All affiliated student groups will have ONE vote PER GROUP. The deadline for voting will be 5 January 2014.
- In the event that fewer than 12 student groups vote (10%), or that the result is tied, the STAN Committee will select a candidate from those standing in the election.
- Once a candidate has been chosen by the Student Network, that person will need to formally request a nomination form from AIUK by 8th January 2014, and return the completed form by 15th January. If other networks put forward candidates for the Network place on the Board, there will be an election.
- Ballot papers will be sent to members entitled to vote on or before Wednesday 12th February 2014 (with a voting deadline of Friday 18 April 2014).
- Please note: this will be a competitive election, and being chosen as the representative of the Student Network does not guarantee that you will be elected to the board.
